PL1554 PROPOSED ROAD SIGN: 'OLD GOOLE WELCOMES CAREFUL DRIVERS'

Nicola Vause addressed Members stating that she had been a resident of Old Goole for 46 years, she pays £128.00 per month Council Tax and would like the signs to read Old Goole instead of Goole.

The Town Clerk explained that Old Goole is not a Parish and has no legal status, it is part of the parish of Goole.

Councillor B Jeffreys informed Members that she had taken the issue to the East Riding Council in October. She said Goole Renaissance Group is currently looking at the needs of Old Goole.

Councillor B Jeffreys **PROPOSED** that the road sign say 'Old Goole'.

This was **SECONDED** by Councillor Head.

Councillor O'Neil stated that this was her proposal. She had requested the signage as she feels that the people of Old Goole need their own identity.

Councillor Frost informed Members that Goole Renaissance Group no longer exists. It is now the Local Growth Partnership.

Councillor M Boatman stated that the Group has a meeting coming up. He said that this issue had been raised with him previously and East Riding Council agrees in principle. They need a Minute from Goole Town Council in order to progress the issue.

Councillor Holbrough asked how many signs there would be as it is not stated in the proposal.

A discussion took place regarding where Old Goole starts.

Councillor Frost informed Members that South Street is the start of Old Goole.

Councillor Holbrough **PROPOSED** that there should be two signs saying 'Old Goole' close to South Street and on Swinefleet Road.

This was **SECONDED** by Councillor D Jeffreys.

Members **RESOLVED** to accept the proposal.
