GTC2850 **UPDATE FROM EAST RIDING WARD COUNCILLORS**

Members were in receipt of the above reports



Councillor B Jeffreys informed Members of some additional projects not mentioned in the report of herself and Councillor D Jeffreys.

These included the demolition of the Phoenix building, trimming of trees next to the Working Mens Club and the clearance of the plot of land between Manor Road and Percy Street. They also discussed quotes for the South Park toilets and hardstanding which have been given to the Town Clerk.

A discussion took place between the Town Clerk, RFO and Councillor Head as to who needed the quotes first. The Town Clerk stated that quotes need to be seen by the Council first in order to appoint contractors. The RFO is compiling a file for all Towns Deal Board quotes.

Councillor Head asked for quotes to be sent to her as TDB representative saying she could then email them to the RFO.

Councillor D Jeffreys informed Members that he is on the East Riding's Climate Change Committee. He said that climate change is an issue of concern to many people. He wants to reassure people that lots is happening behind the scenes. A white paper from the LEP Humberside with a full report due out in August will make very interesting reading.

A discussion took place regarding the Environment Committee with Councillor Moiser stating that it is Councillor Harrison not Councillor Whitehead, who is on the Committee.

Councillor Head suggested asking Councillor Harrison whether she wants to relinquish her position on the Committee.

Councillors B and D Jeffreys left the Meeting at this point.

ERYC Councillor Coultish discussed his report stating that he had just put a paragraph together for the meeting and there were many other ongoing issues.

Councillor Raspin stated that it is good to know that lots is being done behind the scenes.
