**Minutes of meeting held on 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2022 at 7.12pm**

**GTC2905** **APOLOGIES**

Apologies were received from Councillors Marshall, Moiser, Penn, and Whitehead.

The Chair (Councillor Bailey) reminded the public that under standing order 3e members of the public may make representations and give evidence at a meeting which they are entitled to attend in respect of business on the agenda at Full Council, a time limit of 5 minutes per person will be allowed and public participation shall not exceed 15 minutes.

**TO ESTABLISH A WORKING PARTY TO ASSIST IN THE BUSINESS PLANNING AND PROJECT ENGAGEMENT PROCESSES FOR THE VPG TOWNS DEAL PROJECT**

The Town Clerk informed Members that £2.1 million has been agreed in principle for the VPG. Goole Town Council has to submit a business plan/bid in line with The Green Book. A Working Party can assist with shaping the project.

A discussion took place regarding who would like to sit on the Working Party. Councillors Bottomley, Cooper, D Jeffreys, Raspin and Turner put themselves forward.

Councillor Handley informed members that once the group is established, other people could be invited to join.
