# PR2262 TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE VICTORIA PLEASURE GROUNDS TOWN DEAL PROJECT

Members were in receipt of the above report.

The Town Clerk informed Members that there is a statutory obligation to place Contracts such as this on the Government Procurement Site and it was also advertised on My Tenders, the largest site for public sector contracts. There were only a disappointing seven expressions of interest, one of these dropped out straight away and four didn't respond. This left the Council with a choice of two companies.

The Town Clerk informed Members that tenders had been reviewed by himself, the Chair of the Town Deal Board and Councillor Cooper. The tenders were marked on quality and cost and SWA proved to be the most cost effective.

Following lengthy discussion, Councillor D Jeffreys **PROPOSED** that the contract for Consultancy Services for the Victoria Pleasure Grounds be awarded to SWA.

This was SECONDED by Councillor Moiser.

It was **RESOLVED** that the contract for consultancy services for the Victoria Pleasure Grounds be awarded to SWA.

On being put to the vote Members voted: 9 For, 1 Abstain.
