

Dear Cemetery visitor,

The Council has seen a significant increase of memorabilia placed on the grassed areas of the lawn sections in the Cemetery, which is a breach of the rules and regulations;

This impedes on the grass cutting and strimming operations and impacts on the overall appearance of the Cemetery. Therefore can all visitors to these areas, please refrain from placing items on the grassed area and adhere to the regulations and only place items on the memorial base or concrete plinth.

We thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

Lawned Sections

- No kerbs of any kind are permitted within these sections of the cemetery grounds.
- All vases and memorabilia must be placed on the concrete foundation stone either side of the headstone and must not be placed on the grass area of the grave.
- No items made of glass or ceramic are permitted
- Items on metal stakes, sticks or hooks need to be placed in the flower container provided, and must not exceed 12 inches in height
